### ABSTRACT:

*This is the age of information explosion and we all are living in this era. The growth of information is very fast. In any field or discipline we found lots of information. So abundance of information is a major problem that we faced today not only in print publishing but also in web publishing. Web has become the fast and reachable source of information in the current time. It is a more convenient tool for the students as it is easier to use and collect information to carry out research. But it has also got some problem in ascertaining information accuracy and relevancy. Web provides more than enough sources to the information seeker which may not be useful for his/her purpose. That is why the information seeker needs to be a skilled one, so that he/she can easily find out the suitable and relevant information from the source. And also it is very much necessary for the information seeker to be able to evaluate the information collected from the web. So evaluation of websites is become very important. In this current study the investigator has made an attempt to evaluate websites available in an important area of interest "History of Gujarat".*

### INTRODUCTION:

We all are living in 21<sup>st</sup> century which belongs to the era of information and its use. Presently information plays a major role in the development of the society and also in every step of our life. Growth of a country totally depends on how much information it can produce, consume and use. Information can be obtained through various sources like print, non print material, internet, etc. Now



a day's information can be easily accessible through the World Wide Web. The current trend is that people prefer to use information from websites available in internet.

The services available on internet have been increased day by day, which has become channel for communication where text, sound, video, graphics are easily available. It provides a wealth of information to the users. It is a source of up to date information for all the disciplines. It is very easy to use; both for finding information and for publishing it electronically.

### OBJECTIVES:

The primary objective of the present study is to evaluate websites on "History of Gujarat" for users who need information on this topic from websites. The precise objectives formulated for this study are as follows:

1. To select and identify good websites on "History of Gujarat."
2. To provide best websites on "History of Gujarat".
3. To evaluate the selected websites based on the criteria decided for their evaluation.
4. To rank the evaluated websites.

### NEED:

There is no central governing body for Internet publishing. It's extremely easy, cheap and fast to publish on the Internet. There is no system of quality control; there are no editors; and documents can be easily falsified and/or copied. As long as the Web retains these qualities of freedom, it will also remain unmonitored and unregulated. This, therefore, leaves a large responsibility on us, the user, to carefully and critically evaluate the Web sites we use as information sources.

When we search any query on the internet it provides us immense number of retrieval. It is very difficult for the information users whether they are scholars or common men to find out the relevant and useful information from the web. In the internet list of abundant websites get retrieved as per the search strategy. All the retrieved websites are not useful for their purpose. Anyone can create a website and also can post into the web, so it is very difficult to find out the good websites. Finding



good websites on any topic is very time consuming and requires skill to judge them. To overcome this problem there is a need to evaluate websites available in various subjects and therefore website evaluation is a very important area to study. On internet when a user types a keyword on his/her topic, it retrieves many websites. At the very first sight it seems that all the websites that appears in front of the user will be useful. But when we click the URL of any one of the websites then it may retrieve irrelevant information to the user. The user has to check the entire website one by one to satisfy his/her need. It is wastage of time as well as money and at last he/she may not get any productive information. So evaluation of websites is become very important.

### STATEMENT OF THE PROBLEM:

Through this study the investigator has made an attempt to evaluate websites available in an important area of interest "History of Gujarat". In this subject a large numbers of websites are available in the internet. Many of them are commercial and do not have authentic information and some have little information. So it is very difficult for the users to select only those websites which are reliable and can provide relevant information. Through this study, therefore websites providing information on "History of Gujarat" are evaluated systematically applying some approved criteria and at the end a list of good and authentic websites on this topic is prepared and ranked. The present study covered only those websites which are created by governments, institutions, individuals and some extent travel agencies which are good. Fifteen websites which are in public access domain were selected from the evaluation purpose. Only one website is chosen which is hosted by travel and tours' company. "History of Gujarat" is a very important topic not only for the people of Gujarat but also for the people outside Gujarat. This study will be helpful for the students, researchers, tourists and all the people who want to know about the history of Gujarat.

### METHODOLOGY:

To collect data for this study, various methods were used. First of all to access the websites on "History of Gujarat" internet sites were browsed. Although a vast number of websites are retrieved only few were found to be relevant on the topic. These websites form as the sample website and are selected for evaluation.



To search the relevant websites popular search engine "Google" was used by the investigator. There are some other search engines like AltaVista, Google Chrome, Mamma, Meta crawler, Yahoo, etc. They also provided same websites. Therefore the investigator found it more appropriate to use the Google search engine only to make the search more appropriate but also to make the search more systematic. The investigator used eight general criteria for evaluating the websites such as Authority, Purpose, Accuracy, Currency, Coverage, Accessibility, Style and Interactivity. The investigator collected the data through direct observation of the resources on the subject from the selected websites and also visited a number of websites depending upon the links and also through the reference provided there. During searching websites and collecting relevant data for the study, the investigator faced many problems. A lot of confusion was also aroused whether to consider some sites or not for some reasons. Some sites were found out easily while some sites had not.

Data or content analysis method was applied in this study. At the first stage evaluation was done by going through the face value of index of the websites displayed by the search engine. Then the contents of the information of the websites were analyzed under the eight criteria which are described in detail in the next chapter. A check list that contained 22 check points under the eight criteria was prepared. To evaluate the content of each website against each criteria, two values that are: either value '1' or '0' was assigned to each check point. If the required feature was present then it was assigned as '1' otherwise '0' for its absence. Then the points were added to find out the total points obtained by each of the websites. After that the websites were ranked according to the total scores they obtained. That means the websites measured as well had scored highest points.

### ABOUT GUJARAT AND ITS HISTORY:

Gujarat is a state in northwestern India, on the border with Pakistan and Rajasthan in the north east, Madhya Pradesh in the east, and Maharashtra and the Union territories of Diu, Daman, Dadra and Nagar Haveli in the south. The Arabian Sea borders the state both to the west and the south west. Gujarat has a glorious past in many respects. History of the Gujarat can be divided into three parts: ancient, medieval and modern. It has a very rich maritime history as the coastal area of Gujarat has spread over 1600 km. Signs of civilization in the region dated back to the period from 3000 BC to



1500 BC. The region was part of the Mauryan Empire in the 3rd century BC under the King Ashoka. In 1818, the English East India Company took control of Gujarat and administered the state through local princely rulers. With the independence of India in 1947, Gujarat became part of the state of Bombay. In 1960, Bombay state was split up, and Gujarat was formed from the northern and western portions, which were predominantly Gujarati-speaking areas.

### 1. Ranking of the websites

Table 1 shows the ranking of the all websites evaluated under this study. This table has three columns which contain ranking of the 15 websites, total points scored by the websites and serial number of the websites. Among the 15 websites one website that is serial no. 5 in the list scores 22 points and stands top where as two websites score 21 points each. From the table it is clear that majority nine websites have scored 19 points. The least score is 11 and website no. 22 has that score. Name and URL of all these websites can be seen by visiting Table 13A and 13B which is provided in the later part of this chapter or through the description part of the websites provided earlier by the investigator.
