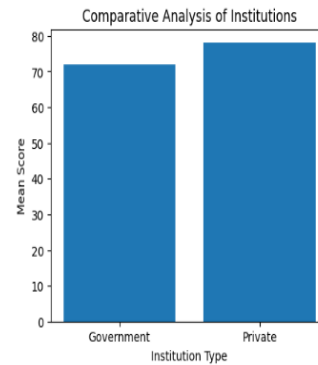

#### Impact on Teaching Aptitude

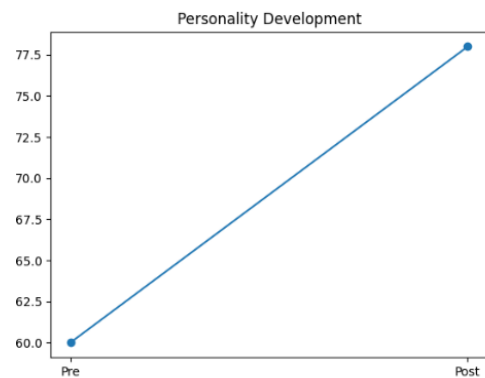
Stage	Mean Score

#### Impact on Personality Traits

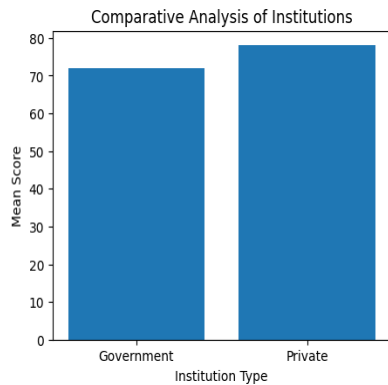
Stage	Mean Score
